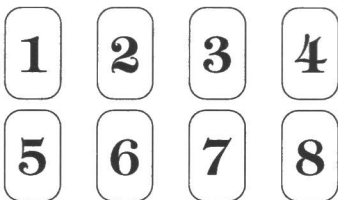
## **ABOUT ROBERT PETRO**

## **EIGHT CARD SPREAD GENERAL READING**

**The Eight Card Spread has been designed to give you an overall view of the conditions present in your life at this time. It will reveal to you the past, present, and future conditions. It is recommended the reader shuffle the cards. Then place the deck in front of the person to be read. Before they cut the deck, they are to ask, in silence, the one most relevant question to themselves. They are to cut the deck in 3 stacks, from right to left. You, the reader, will restack the cards, left to right and begin your spread.**

## **EIGHT CARD SPREAD**



In the first row, Card 1 is placed to the top left, followed by Card 2, 3, and 4. In the second row is Card 5, 6, 7, and 8. The reader will then start the reading with Card 1. Each card is numbered. The reader has the option to use these numbers in reference to how long the cycle of that card will last (i.e. #12 could represent 12 days, weeks, or months). The person being read should write down or record the reading for future review.

## **EIGHT CARD SPREAD PLUS ONE**

Once you have completed the Eight Card Spread reading, you can pull one more card which is the "FINAL OUTCOME" of the entire reading. This card may provide more insight and clarity concerning what direction you might need to take at this time.
