Fortune Cards

A simple, archetypal guide to your future and fortune! As with all fortune cards you should always trust your instincts when reading and use your intuition, the definitions are there to guide you only.

Cards should be interpreted towards the subject of the reading and can be drawn individually or as part of a spread to help answer your questions or divine your path. One of the simplest (and oldest) forms of reading is the three card spread, which looks at the past, present and future surrounding a question.

Card Definitions:

I - The Eye - Clarity of vision,
intuition, focus.

Reversed: Self-deception,
daydreaming, lack of focus.

II - The Heart - Love, affection,
romance.

Reversed: Heartache, break-ups,
negative relationships.

III - The Hand - Friendship,
offering help, reaching for goals.

Reversed: Help needed, reaching
out, incomplete goals.

IV - The Tree - Earth Element -
Knowledge, growth, strong roots.

Reversed: Instability,
discontentment, lack of
restrictions.

V - The Feather - Air Element -
Freedom, changes, relaxation.

Reversed: Distance, losing your
way, excitement of the unknown.

VI - The River - Water Element -
Adventure, rejuvenation, guidance.

Reversed: Overwhelmed, turning
point, carried away.

VII - The Flame - Fire Element -
Passion, purification, spontaneity.
Reversed: Recklessness,
destruction, anger.

VIII - The Moon - Progress,
personal growth, solitude.
Reversed: trapped in a cycle,
unfulfilled, influenced by others.

IX - The Sun - Energy, exuberance,
warmth.
Reversed: Ego, obsession, vitality.

X - Chaos - Change, surprise,
chaos.
Reversed: Same

XI - The Owl - Wisdom, calm,
justice.
Reversed: Pride, ignorance,
judgement.

XII - The Rat - Growth, personal
wealth, complacency.
Reversed: Warning.

XIII - The Black Cat - Your luck
will change.
Reversed: Same

XIV - The Snake - Seduction,
temptation, possibilities.
Reversed: Rebirth, confidence,
upheaval.

XV - The Wolf - Loyalty, bonding,
conformity.
Reversed: Disloyalty, broken
bonds, new beginnings.

XVI - The Door - Opportunities,
curiosity, action.
Reversed: Closed doors, endings,
inaction.

XVII - The Compass - Journeys,
travel, right path.
Reversed: Lost ways, uncertainty,
risks.

XVIII - The Anchor - Steadiness,
stillness, security.
Reversed: Adrift, struggling, free.

XIX - The Key - Secrets, self-
control, patience.
Reversed: Openness, honesty,
revelations.

XX - The Dagger - Protection,
justice, assertion.
Reversed: Danger, power, gossip.

XXI - The Horseshoe - Good luck,
peace, contentment
Reversed: luck leaving, change of
fortune.

XXII - The Coins - Good fortune,
fiscal gain, security
Reversed - Investment, addiction,
fiscal loss.

XXIII - The Crown - Recognition,
authority, pride.
Reversed: Obscurity, compromise,
balance.

XXIV - The Wand - Focus,
intention, spirituality
Reversed: Disconnection, lack of
intention, distraction.

XXV - The Cup - Replenishment,
respite, healing
Reversed: Carelessness,
immaturity, intoxication.

XXVI - The Mask - mystery,
illusion, composure.
Reversed: Guile, deception,
insecurity.

XXVII - The Lady - Strength,
dignity, patience.

Reversed: Allure, negligence,
disharmony.

XXVIII - The Lord - Skill,
dedication, vitality.

Reversed: Lack of discipline,
dominating, independence.

XXIX - The Stranger - Mystery,
chances, the unknown.

Reversed: Caution, intrigue,
disruptive energy.

XXX - The Trickster - Mischief,
fun, uncertainty.

Reversed: Same.

XXXI - The Witch - Inspiration,
moderation, courage.

Reversed: Injustice, audacity,
inner-strength.

XXXII - Death - Change, release,
endings.

Reversed: Stagnation, passivity,
fear of the unknown.
